

The Surety & Fidelity Industry Intern and Scholarship Program

There has never been a better time to work in insurance.

With the industry in need of a new generation of diverse talent, The Surety & Fidelity Association of America is working to identify and invest in the future of insurance: young people like you! One way the Association does this is through The Surety Foundation, which matches qualified underrepresented students with insurance companies for paid internships. Students majoring in business, finance, economics, accounting, and risk management & insurance are especially encouraged to apply.

Upon successful completion of an industry internship, students are eligible to receive up to a \$5,000 scholarship!

Eligibility Requirements

- U.S. Citizenship
- *Underrepresented student who has completed at least their sophomore year
- Ideally, a declared business, finance, economics, accounting or insurance/risk management major
- Minimum overall GPA of at least 3.0 on a 4.0 scale
- Enrollment in an accredited institution as a full-time

undergraduate student and commitment to participate in a six-week (minimum) paid internship with a company in the surety/fidelity industry during the summer following notification of selection and prior to disbursement of scholarship funds

Successful completion of paid internship is required

*The Surety Foundation, the non-profit educational arm of The Surety & Fidelity Association of America, defines underrepresented as those of African-American/Black, Native American/Alaskan Native, Asian/Pacific Islander or Hispanic ethnic origin, as well as women, disabled students, veterans and those identifying as LGBTQ.
